- Fill out own time sheet accurately and turn into supervisor before leaving
- Cooperatively work in a team with other umpires and supervisor
- Attend all games scheduled to work
- Communicate with Recreation Supervisor in a timely manner regarding inability to make scheduled games or with issues what may arise during work
- Willingness to learn from experienced peers
