Basketball Rules

2008

- GAMES:** Three game guarantee.
- OFFICIATING:** Whenever possible, games will be officiated by certified referees from the Sheridan Officials Association.
- TIMEKEEPER:** The Sheridan Rec. District will provide a timekeeper for all games.
- SCOREKEEPER:** The designated home team will provide a scorekeeper to keep the official book. **The home team will be the team listed Last in the schedule.**
- ROSTER:** Players can only play for one team. Additions/deletions to a roster must be complete by the first game. No changes to the roster will be allowed after the first game.
- FACILITIES:** Games will be played at various gyms in the Sheridan area. A map will be provided to all teams showing the gym sites.
- UNIFORMS:** Teams must have numbered/same colored jerseys. It is recommended that teams show up with 2 sets of tops. (light/dark)
- LINEUPS:** Team coaches will put their lineup in the official book 10 minutes prior to the scheduled game.
- GAME BALL:** Each team must provide a game ball to be used during the game. A woman=s ball will be used for all divisions except 8th and 9th grade boys. (8th / 9th boys will use a regulation men's ball.)
- WARM UP BALL:** Teams will provide their own balls for warm ups.
- CONDUCT:** A team may be suspended from further play for unsportsmanlike behavior by it=s players, coaches, managers or fans.
- SUPERVISORS:** Gym supervisors will be provided by the Sheridan Recreation District and will be responsible for making sure all games get started in a timely manner and that all guests treat the schools with respect.

PLAYING RULES

Normal high school rules will apply in all games with the following exceptions.

1. Games will consist of four 8 minute quarters with a running clock. The clock will stop for free throws and time outs only. The clock will stop on all whistles during the last two minutes of the game.
2. Overtime periods are two minutes in length, with a stopped clock on all whistles. Teams will get one time out per overtime.
3. Three, sixty second timeouts per game will be allowed. Unused time outs will not carry over into overtime.
4. Half time will consist of three minutes.
5. The 3 point shot will be allowed for all divisions.
6. Only during the last two minutes of the game, (no matter what the score) will both teams be allowed to use the full court press in the 5th grade division.
7. Zone defenses and presses, except in the last two minutes of the game, are illegal in the 5th grade division. Violations will result in a first time warning, thereafter a free throw will be awarded with the shooting team staying in possession of the ball.
8. Zones and presses are legal during 6th 7th 8th and 9th grade games.
9. Players must compete in their own grade classifications. Exception: Players may play in an older division. Players may play on one team only.
10. Once the tournament has started, pickup players will not be allowed without the approval of the gym supervisor and then for emergencies only.
11. Adults must accompany their teams in dressing rooms during games and at all other tournament events.
12. Shoes cannot be worn into the facility and then used for the game. Shoes must be non-marking.
