This role offers an opportunity to contribute to the beautification and functionality of our community's outdoor spaces.

JOB DUTIES/TASKS

- As part of a crew prepare ball fields for practices and games
- Perform routine maintenance tasks such as mowing, trimming, and edging grass.
- Assist in troubleshooting irrigation and mechanical issues
- Maintain cleanliness and safety of park facilities, including restrooms, picnic areas, and playgrounds.
- Repair and maintain park infrastructure such as benches, fences, and signage.
- Commit to working in and maintaining a clean and safe work space
- Contribute to the upkeep of Kendrick Pool & Ice Cream Stand
- Develop skills to drive manual transmission
- Load and unload equipment from truck and trailer
- Follow established safety protocols and procedures to ensure a safe working environment.
- Work as a team to achieve maintenance standards
- Assist with planting, watering, and caring for flowers, trees, and shrubs.
- Develop Turf Management skills
- Operate and maintain landscaping equipment, vehicles, and tools in a safe and efficient manner.

- Communicate effectively with supervisors, coworkers, and the public.
